10 comfortable & retro-looking stylish seats and 22 divine & incredibly original courses.

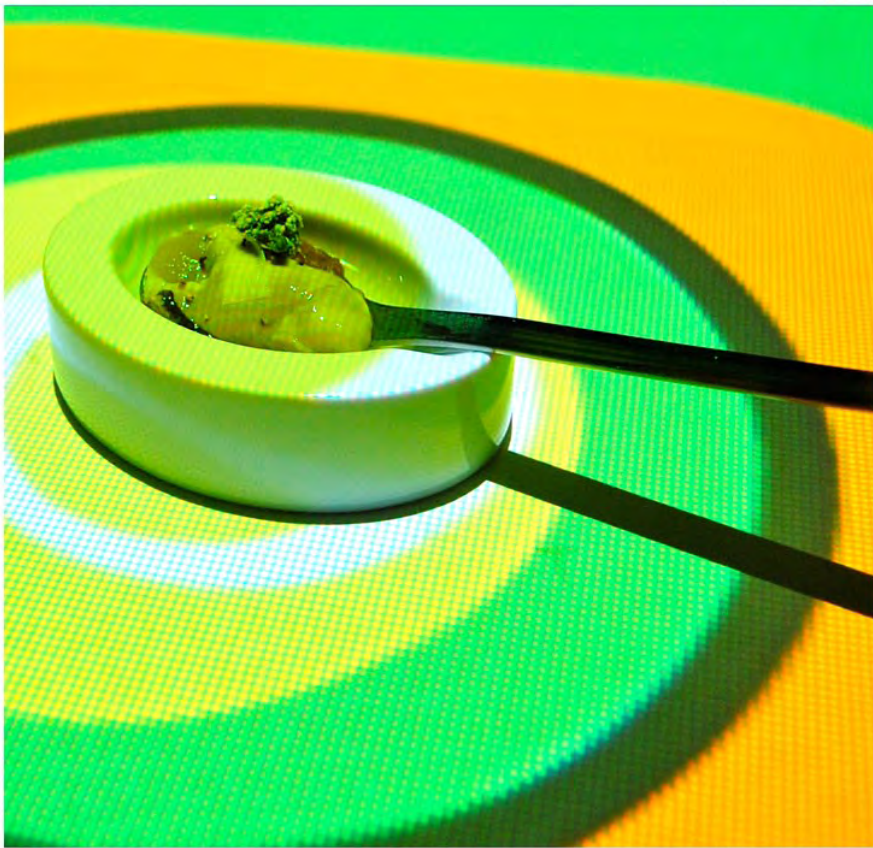
