#### shanghai Culinary Theatre

### THAILAND Fabric of Society

Coinciding with Queen Sirikit's 80th birthday is the grand opening of the new QUEEN SIRIKIT MUSEUM OF TEXTILES, located on the grounds of The Grand Palace in Bangkok. One gallery displays Queen Sirikit's designer ensembles, including pieces by Pierre Balmain and Erik Mortensen that use fabrics created by the queen's Support Foundation. Another depicts how her sense of style led her to create a new national dress for women in the 1960s.
